Vehicles registered in Cache County with model years **less than six years old** are not required to have an emission test. Vehicles **six years old and greater** that have even-numbered model years must have an emission test in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have oddnumbered model years must have an emission test in odd-numbered years.

Exemptions:

- New vehicles with an MSO
- Implement of husbandry
- Farm truck
- Any vehicle used for maintenance or construction and not designed or licensed to operate on the highway
- Any motorcycle or motor driven cycle
- Electric vehicles
- Any vintage or custom vehicle
- Off highway vehicles
- Any diesel vehicle 1997 and older
- Any diesel vehicle with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
- Any gasoline (and non-diesel based alternative fuel) vehicles 2008 and newer model year with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
- Any gasoline (and non-diesel based alternative fuel) vehicles 1996 to 2007 model years with a GVWR greater than 8,500 lbs.

Commercial Vehicle Requirements

Safety Inspection: All Commercial Vehicles require an annual safety inspection.

Safety Inspections are not a pre-requisite for registration. However, the certificates are required to be kept in the vehicle at all times.

Emissions: Vehicles with model years less than six years old need an emissions inspection once every two years. Vehicles in this category that have even-numbered model years must have emissions inspections in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have odd-numbered model years must have emissions inspections in odd-numbered years. Vehicles six years old & older require emissions every year. Emissions for gas powered vehicles are due in Cache, Davis, Salt Lake, Utah and Weber counties.

Emissions Exemptions by County

- Weber- Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, vehicles 1967 & older, motorcycles, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, diesel vehicles 1997 & older, diesel vehicles with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
- Davis- Davis- Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, vehicles 1967 & older, motorcycles, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, heavy-duty diesel vehicles with an IRP registration and GVWR 26,000 lbs. or more and have logged more than 50% of miles outside of Utah and are within the first three (3) model years
- Salt Lake- Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, vehicles 1967 & older, motorcycles, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, diesel vehicles 1997 & older with a GVWR 14,000 lbs. or less
- Utah- Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, motorcycles, vehicles 1967 & older, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, diesel vehicles 1997 & older, diesel vehicles five years old and newer, diesel vehicles with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.

Vehicles registered in Davis County with model years **less than six years old** are required to have an emission test once every two years. Vehicles in this category with even-numbered model years must have an emission test in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have odd-numbered model years must have an emission test in odd-numbered years. Light, Medium and Heavy duty diesel powered vehicles in Davis County follow requirements on left.

Exemptions:

- New vehicles with an MSO
- Any non-diesel powered vehicle w/ model year 1967 & older
- Any vehicle used for maintenance or construction and not designed or licensed to operate on the highway
 - Heavy duty diesel vehicles that meet all of the following criteria:
 - ✓ Have an apportioned registration
 - ✓ Are 26,000 lbs. GVWR or greater
 - ✓ Miles logged outside Utah 50% plus
 - ✓ Are within the first three (3) model years

Vehicles in this category that have even-numbered model years must have an emission test in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have oddnumbered model years must have an emission test in oddnumbered years.

- Any vehicle w/ model year 1967 & older
 - Any diesel vehicle w/ model year 1997 & older with a GVWR less than 14,000 lbs.
- All implements of husbandry
- Off highway vehicles
- Electric vehicles

Vehicles in this category that have even-numbered model years must have an emission test in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have odd-numbered model years must have an emission test in odd-numbered years. **Diesel powered vehicles that are 1997 – 2017 require an emissions inspection in Utah County.**

Exemptions:

- New vehicles with an MSO
- Any vehicle 1967 & older
- Implement of husbandry (Farm) vehicles
- Any vehicle used for maintenance or construction and not designed or licensed to operate on the highway
- Any motorcycle or motor driven cycle
- Electric vehicles
- Any motor vehicle which is powered by an engine that is 650cc or less.
- Any motor vehicle which is powered by a 2-cycle Engine.
- Diesel powered vehicles 1996 & older
- Any vintage or custom vehicle
- Off highway vehicles
